Dear Ms. Stenehjem,

The Secretary of State's office has finished its review of the Election Integrity Violation Report received January 26, 2022. Specifically, the allegation asserted that Dr. Angela Taylor failed to file multiple Financial Disclosure Statements (FDS) by the deadline.

Dr. Taylor has been cooperative with our office and has asked for a waiver of civil penalties. The Secretary of State's office has approved the waiver of civil penalty fees pursuant to NRS 294A.420.

The Secretary of State, as the Chief Election Officer for the State of Nevada, is responsible for enforcement of the election laws contained in Title 24 of the Nevada Revised Statutes; however, the FDS's have been filed and the civil penalty fees have been waived. As a result, no further action will be taken by this office and this file will be closed.
